Andy's Festival activities raise £26K

The September FWPS Committee meeting was thrilled to hear that our stewarding

teams at the 2007 Glastonbury Festival had raised around £26,000. The teams are annually recruited, trained and organised by Andy Townend. The biggest possible THANK YOU to Andy and to all those who stewarded for him this year.

Progress on our Playground Apparatus Appeal

We appointed a sub-committee to work with Issa Bonnar in applying for external funding to meet the £28,000 project costs. To avoid VAT on apparatus purchases our June Committee meeting agreed that funds would be donated to the school to enable them to purchase direct. Both the FWPS and our Head teacher, Helen Burchell, have been applying for funding and we await news of the school's application for just under £9,000 of National Lottery Funds; we are hopeful as the original FWPS application was only turned down because we would not be not the purchasers of the apparatus. Should this grant application fail, the September FWPS meeting agreed to use Festival money to make up the shortfall.

Our thanks to the Somerset Partnership Fund (£5,000), an anonymous local donor (£4,000), County Councillors Ken Maddock (£743) and Alan Gloak (£250), the Pilgrims Masonic Lodge of Glastonbury (£500) and the Love and Honour Masonic Lodge of Shepton Mallet (£500) for their generous support, to the School Council (£135) and FWPS Summer Fair organisers (approx £2,000). Thank you also to our sub-committee of Issa, Arabella Browne, Marion Colman (Deputy Chair of our school Governing Body and local Parish Councillor), Julia Hutchison and Roger Longman; Roger got on his bike to raise £85.

The FWPS Christmas Fair is on Friday 7 December.

Our sub-committee has already met twice and the next two meetings will be on Tuesday 16 October and Thursday 8 November. If you would like to be involved or attend the meeting please collar Libby in the playground or call her on 01458 850388.
